

1.1 About the College

B.N. College, Dhubri is one of the premier institutions of higher education in Western Assam. 1.3 Adoption of NISP in B.N. College, Dhubri

Mr. Sumit Dey, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, B.N College has been nominated as the coordinator of NISP adoption and implementation in the college. The college has constituted a five member expert committee for the formulation of B.N. College Innovation and Start Up Policy. The expert committee has placed the draft of the innovation and start up policy to the Governing body on 21/01/2021 and it has been approved in the Governing body meeting held on 23/01/2021.

1.4 B.N. College Innovation and Start Up Policy

The B.N. College, Dhubri is committed to implement the national innovation and start up policy in the college for the greater interest of students and faculty member and the community as a

- The college will arrange field/ industry visit for the interested students and faculty members time to time.
- The college will develop resource mobilization plan for supporting pre-incubation, incubation infrastructure and facilities. A sustainable financial strategy will be framed in order to reduce the organizational constraints to work on the entrepreneurial agenda.
- For expediting the decision making, hierarchical barriers will be minimized and individual autonomy and ownership of initiatives should be promoted.
- New ideas will be continuously monitored and possible support shall be extended.
- The college is committed to extend the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship beyond the college boundaries. All possible support shall be provided to the community members interested in innovation and entrepreneurship.
- An incubation centre shall be established as per the guidelines of IIC, Ministry of Education, GoI.

- The college will provide necessary break to the students and faculty members to work on start-up, innovation, entrepreneurship etc.
- The college will facilitate the startup activities/ technology development by allowing students/ faculty/ staff to use institute infrastructure and facilities, as per the choice of the potential entrepreneur.
