Policy on Scholarships and Freeships B. N. College, Dhubri

Introduction

B. N. College, Dhubri is a premier institution of higher learning located in the western part of Assam. The college attracts a large number of students of the region including the remote villages and riverine (*char*) areas. Dhubri is an aspirational district categorised by the NITI AYOG, Government of India. According to the NITI AYOG, the Aspirational Districts are those economically backward districts that are 'affected by poor socio-economic indicators'. Being located in the aspirational district, a large number of students from economically weaker sections of the region get enrolled in the college to undertake higher studies. Considering the economic conditions of the students, the college has designed a policy to provide scholarships and freeships under Students' Aid Fund to the students belonging to the BPL (Below Poverty Line) category on merit basis.

Objective of Policy

a. To provide financial assistance to students under BPL category on merit basis.

Policy Design and Implementation

The college has designed a policy to grant scholarships and freeships under Students' Aid Fund at institutional level in every year. The policy is designed to include maximum number of students. For that purpose, a small amount of contribution is collected from the students at the time of admission. To avail the scholarships and freeships, the students are asked to apply for the same after notification from the college. The applications received from the students are scrutinized by a committee constituted by the Principal of the college. After scrutinizing all the applications, the committee prepare a list of students on merit basis from the BPL category. On the recommendation of the scrutiny committee, the amount is transferred to the bank account number of the students.

Conclusion

The policy is a welfare measure adopted by the college to support and encourage the students of the BPL category. It will certainly boost up their moral and also made a positive impact on the teaching-learning process in the college. The policy is a small step in realizing the vision and mission of the College.
