

Annexure-I

There were 3(three) technologically enabled classrooms prior to RUSA-I Grant. With the help of RUSA-I Grant, 3(three) new technologically enabled classrooms were constructed at a cost of Rs.37,35,581.00 (Rupees thirteen seven lakh thirty five thousand five hundred eighty one) only. Right now, there are total 10(ten) nos. of technologically enabled classrooms in the college.



Annexure-II

There was 1(one) small Boys' Common Room prior to RUSA-I Grant. With RUSA-I Grant, 1(one) new building was constructed with 2(two) rooms and 2(two) toilets at a cost of Rs.32,38,062.00 (Rupees thirty two lakhs thirty eight thousand sixty two) only. One of the rooms is used as Gymnasium of the college. Students, teachers and staffs of the college regularly visit the Gymnasium for physical exercise.



Annexure-III

There were 4(four) toilet blocks for boys prior to RUSA-I Grant out of which 1(one) was in a very depraved condition which was renovated with the help of RUSA-I Grant at a cost of Rs.4,99,127.00 (Rupees four lakh ninety nine thousand one hundred twenty seven) only.



Annexure-IV

The college canteen which was in a bad shape prior to RUSA-I Grant has been renovated with a cost of Rs.5,00,000.00 (Rupees five lakhs) only. After renovation, the canteen has become an attraction point for the students where they can get good quality food under hygienic condition and chat with the fellow students. There is provision of separate space for staffs in the canteen after renovation.



Annexure-V

Under Campus Development following projects were undertaken through RUSA-I Grant:

(a) Upgradation of water supply arrangement (Amount of expenditure = Rs.24,98,747/-)



(b) Upgradation of drainage system. &
(c) Upgradation of internal road.

(Amount of expenditure = Rs.25,99,074/-)




Under the project 'upgradation of water supply arrangement', a water treatment plant was constructed. The entire college campus including the Boys & Girls' Hostel now receive treated drinking water after the completion of this project. The project has improved the quality of drinking water in the college campus.

The college campus used to get submerged by rain/flood water due to poor internal drainage system.Besides, the internal roads were also in a bad condition. By using grant from RUSA-I, a part of the internal roadswas renovated with coloured paving blocks. This has added a new dimension to the look of the college besides improving the condition of the internal road. The renovation of the drainage system has largely solved the problem of water logging.

Annexure-VI

With the help of RUSA-I Grant, one of the classrooms of the college was converted to laboratory for the Department of Chemistry at a cost of Rs.7,99,882.00 (Rupees seven lakh ninety nine thousand eight hundred eighty two) only. It may be mentioned here that M.Sc. in Chemistry was started in the college under G.U. from the session 2016-2017. So, the department was in need of a laboratory for M.Sc. Course. The grant was a great help in converting a classroom into laboratory for the M.Sc. Course. Right now, around 20(twenty) students are pursuing M.Sc. in Chemistry from the college.



Annexure-VII

With the help of RUSA-I Grant college procured some Gym. Equipments at a cost of Rs.4,99,127.00 (Rupees four lakh ninety nine thousand one hundred twenty seven) only for its Gymnasium which has largely improved the facilities in the Gymnasium. Students, teachers and staff are regular users of these facilities.



Annexure-VIII

The college procured 20(twenty) nos. of Desktop Computers by using RUSA-I Grant at a cost of Rs.9,53,800.00 (Rupees nine lakh fifty three thousand eight hundred) only and they are in use in the Library, various departments as well as in the college office. The students are highly benefited as there are more number of computers in the library with internet connection for them to access.



Annexure-IX

The college procured laboratory equipments for the departments of Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Biotechnology with the help of RUSA-I Grant at a cost of Rs.19,65,178.00 (Rupees nineteen lakh sixty five thousand one hundred seventy eight) only. It may be mentioned herethat the new equipments helped in improving the facilities in the laboratory of the departments to a large extent. One Infra-Red Spectrometer was procured at a cost of Rs.10,29,529.00 (Rupees ten lakhs twenty nine thousand five hundred twenty nine) only for the Post Graduate Department of Chemistry which helped in carrying out various projects by the students pursuing M.Sc. in Chemistry.



Annexure-X

A total 2,234 nos. of books were procured with the help of RUSA-I Grant at a cost of Rs.14,19,275.00 (Rupees fourteen lakh nineteen thousand two hundred seventy five) only for various departments of the college. The new books helped in improving facilities in the Central Library of the college.
