



VIGYANAM 1.0: ANNUAL SCIENCE FEST OF B. N. COLLEGE

Rules & Regulations for different events

Participants must register separately for each competition

Date of the event: 27th and 28th March, 2023



1. SCIFARI (Science Model Competition):

Category I: Class V to H. S.

Category II: UG & PG

(Rules are same for both category):

- Candidate should participate in groups consisting minimum 2 members and maximum 3 members.
- Single participants are not allowed.
- Each group can submit only one model.
- The model displayed should be an original and hand done work of the participant.
- The decision of the judges will be the final call.

2. CONNECT THE DOTS (T-shirt Painting Competition):

- Students must participate individually.
- Participants must bring their own T-shirt and colours of their choice.
- Colour of the T-shirt must be either black or white.
- Time allowed to complete the painting is 120 minutes followed by 30 minutes of judgement.

3. FIX THE MIX (Rubik's Cube Competition):

- Students must participate individually.
- Rubik's cube will be provided to each participant.
- If the cube is broken while solving, new cube will not be provided.
- The least time taken by the participant will be the winner.
- The start and end time will be according to the Indian Standard Time.
- The decision of the judges will be the final call.

4. POSTEROLIC (Science Poster Competition):

- Candidate should participate in groups consisting minimum 2 members and maximum 3 members.
- Single participants are not allowed.
- Class VI to XII participants can submit either handwritten or digitally made posters but UG to PG level participants must submit their posters in digital format.
- Participants have to explain their posters within 2 minutes in front of the judges.
- The decision of the judges will be the final call.

5. BEST OUT OF WASTE (Handcraft Competition):

- Students must participate individually.
- Participants must bring their own necessary waste products.
- Time allowed to complete the work is 90 minutes followed by 30 minutes of judgement.

6. THROUGH THE LENS (On Spot Photography):

- Students must participate individually.
- Only mobile phone camera is allowed.
- Watermark of time, date, and name of the participant must be there in the photograph.
- Only one photograph is allowed to submit.
- The photograph should be about the “Biodiversity of B. N. College”.
- Only raw photograph will be accepted. No editing is allowed.
- The decision of the judges will be the final call.

7. SCI-CONFAB (Student’s Seminar/Conference):

- Candidate should participate in groups consisting minimum 1 member and maximum 2 members.
- Participants have to present within 7 minutes followed by a 3 minute of Q&A session.
- Participants must present with a well-made power point slide.
- Participants must submit their abstract and ppt to the event coordinator prior to the event.
- The decision of the judges will be the final call.

8. MOTIF (On Spot Design competition using matchstick/Ice-cream stick):

- Candidate should participate in groups consisting minimum 2 members and maximum 3 members.
- Single participants are not allowed.
- Participants will be provided with 300 number of matchsticks, 20 number of ice-cream sticks and a glue.
- Further requirement of any items will not be provided by the organiser. Participants may bring their own prior the event.
- Time allowed to complete the work is 120 minutes followed by 30 minutes of judgement.

9. Treasure Hunt:

- Participants are allowed with a group of 5 members only.
- Groups will be provided with certain clues.
- Clues will be same for all groups.
- There will be one winning team.
- The judgment will be done on the basis of the time taken by the teams to hunt the treasure.
