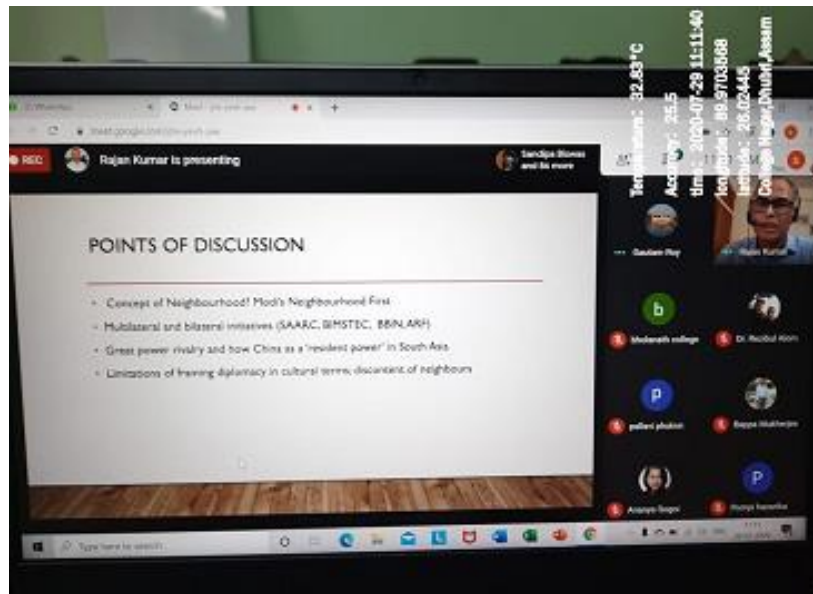
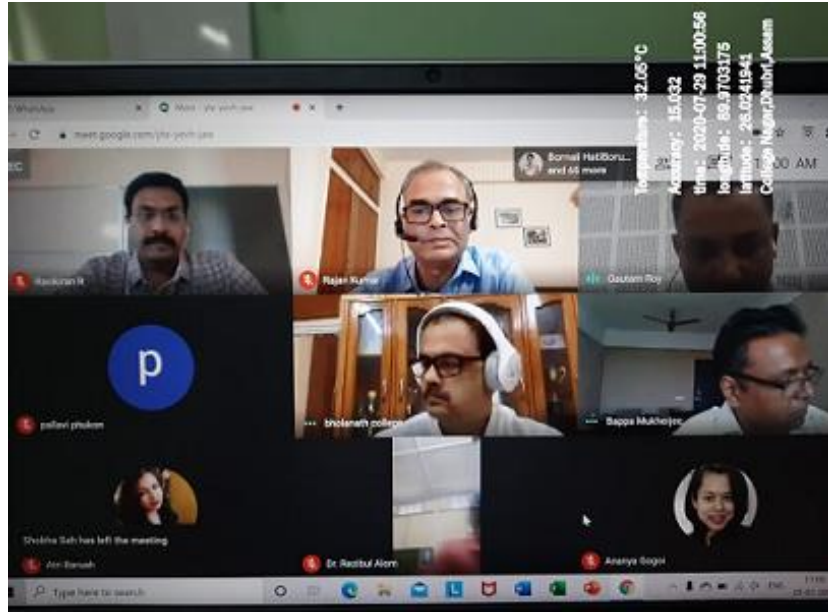
The webinar on – “Trajectory of India's Foreign Policy: The Road Ahead” was divided into two lectures. The first lecture was delivered by Dr. Rajan Kumar, Associate Professor, Centre for Russian and Asian Studies, School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. He spoke on the topic – India's Neighbourhood Policy. In his lecture, Dr. Rajan Kumar highlights the various issues and dynamics of India's neighbourhood

policy and how India should move forward in order to establish cordial relations considering the complex issues. The second lecture was delivered by Dr. Bappaditya Mukherjee, Former Visiting Professor, State University of New York, USA on the topic – ‘Indo-US alignment as a counterweight to China: Promises and Challenges’. Dr. Mukherjee in his lecture raised the issues of India’s growing relations with the United States and the dynamics involved with it. While emphasizing with the relations with China Dr. Mukherjee argues that, India should be cautious dealing with China and India should not overwhelmingly depend upon United States to counter China.
